



# Photo Server Installation Guide

## ProjectRelay Server ReadMe

Project-Relay is a lightweight on-prem photo upload server paired with the Project-Relay Android app.

This guide explains installation, licensing, and operation.

### REQUIREMENTS

- Windows machine with network access to your project share(s)
- ProjectRelay Android app (iOS coming soon)
- A valid license file in the server folder to enable uploads

### DOWNLOADING THE SERVER

Download the ProjectRelay server ZIP from the [Project-Relay.com](https://Project-Relay.com)

Unzip the package to a temporary location such as your Desktop or C:\Temp.

Do NOT unzip directly into the final install folder.

### INSTALLING THE SERVER

1. Open PowerShell as Administrator.
2. Change directory to the folder where you unzipped the download.
3. Run:  
  
`Set-ExecutionPolicy Bypass -Scope Process -Force`  
  
`.\Install-ProjectRelayServer.ps1`

4. The installer will:

- Copy the server files
- Create config.json
- Register the ProjectRelayServer startup task
- Start the server in background mode
- Display the generated server URL

#### POINTING THE MOBILE APP

Enter the server URL into the Project-Relay app (example):

`http://YOURSERVER:5001/upload`

#### APPLYING YOUR LICENSE

After purchase, you will download a file named `projectrelay.license.json`.

Place this file in your `C:\ProjectRelay` folder OR the folder where `ProjectRelayServer.exe` was installed.

Once a request is sent from the app, the license should be recognized. If not, then restart the ProjectRelayServer task (`Restart-ProjectRelayServer.ps1` is included).
